2023 saw the comeback of in-person events, which was a welcome change for both the Board and SDRAN Members. The Open House and the Member Appreciation Event, both help in-person, were well-received by new and continuing members. Many of our SDRAN Programs this year were done in-person and online, which afforded our members a lot of flexibility, permitted for pre-meeting networking time between members and the Board, and kept registrations high.

Thanks to the Education Committee and the RAC Sessions offered both live and as a lecture package in Fall 2023, SDRAN has seen a high number of new memberships. Of note, the “New Membership” report on EZSignUp still accounts for some new memberships renewed by non-new members (Example: Members with expired memberships who renew at a later time are considered new memberships), so it is important to account for some redundancy in these new members. Nevertheless, 2023 has been an excellent year for new memberships. Extra activities offered by SDRAN, such as the Job Hunting Workshop set up by the VP of Programs, offered SDRAN good visibility to people who were new to Regulatory Affairs and wanting to network.

Surveys throughout the year indicated that attendees were generally happy with the variety and quality of events offered. Note that numbers went down this year as 1 survey (related to SDRAN’s July event) collected no responses.

Experience with EZSignUp has been difficult as the platform is not user-friendly, capabilities are limited, and support provided by EZSignUp is not always helpful. Current challenges involve 1) Members not receiving SDRAN email campaigns, 2) Membership expiration emails set up on EZSignUp going to some members whose memberships have not yet expired.

Figure 1: 2023 Program Topic Distribution

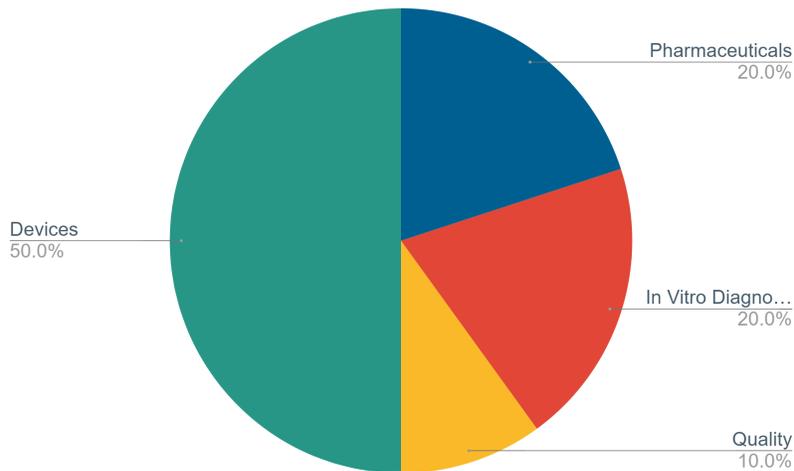

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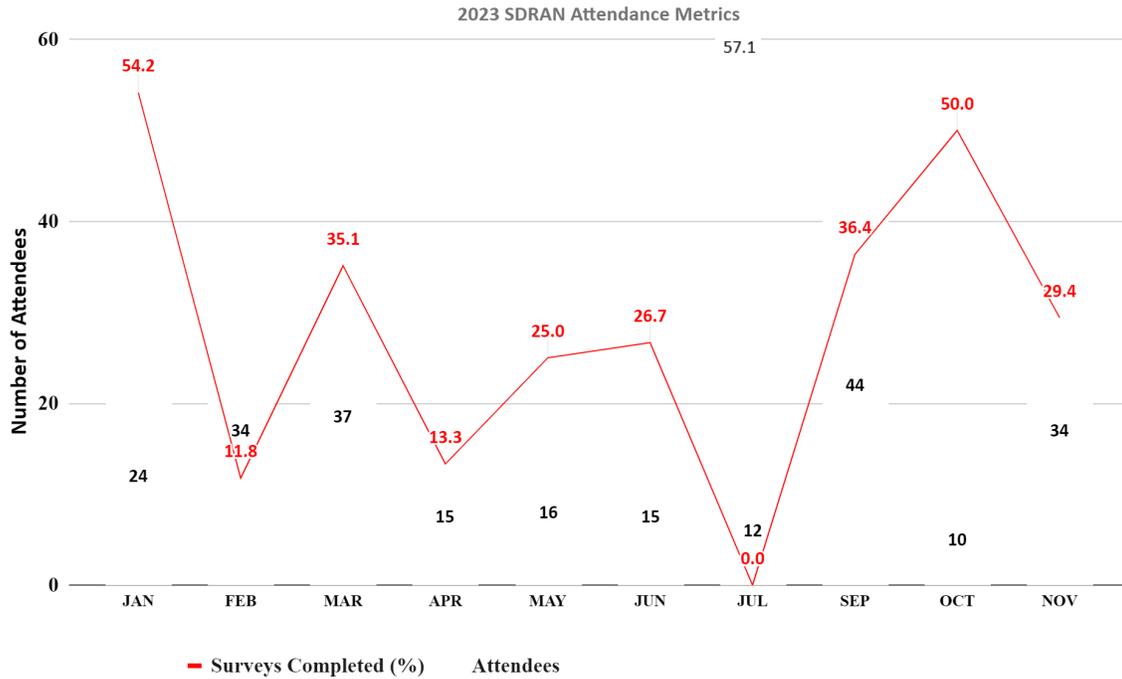
